ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE APPROVAL OF AITAA LIFETIME MEMBERSHIP FEE REQUEST

We are pleased to announce that the AIT approved the AITAA's request to reestablish the automatic collection of the AITAA Lifetime Membership Fee on 12 July 2024 with the remark that 10% of the collected fee will be transferred to the Office of Student Affairs (OSA) for student welfare initiatives.

This decision addresses the longstanding issue of the discontinuation of the automatic collection of the AITAA Lifetime Membership Fee by the previous administration. The change led to a significant decline in subscription rates, raising concerns for both the AITAA Headquarters and National Chapters.

Under the approved plan:

- The automatic collection of the THB 1,000 AITAA Lifetime Membership Fee will be reinstated.
- The collection process will commence either at the start of new students' programs (beginning with the August 2024 intake) or as part of the clearance process for graduating students (starting with the 142nd class in December 2024).
- The collected fees will be transferred to the AITAA Operating Account (Siam Commercial Bank A/C 4060005183) at the end of each term, semester, or inter-semester.

The AITAA Lifetime Membership Fee fosters a sense of community, ownership, and belonging among AIT graduates. It enables graduates to become active members of the AITAA network, enhancing professional connections and supporting sustainable alumni engagement.

We thank everyone for their support and cooperation in implementing this initiative, which strengthens the ties between AIT and its alumni while contributing to student welfare programs.

Automatic Collection of AITAA Lifetime Membership Fee (THB 1,000)

from AIT Graduating Students

Following my election and soon after assuming the role of President of the AIT Alumni Association (AITAA), I discovered that the automatic collection of the AITAA Lifetime Membership Fee was discontinued by the previous AIT Administration. Consequently, graduating students were given the option to pay the Lifetime Membership Fee to AITAA, which has led to a significantly low subscription rate from each graduating batch. This situation has become a growing concern for both the AITAA HQ and the national Chapters.

Thus, the AITAA humbly requests that AIT re-establish the automatic collection of the AITAA Lifetime Membership Fee of THB 1,000 from each AIT graduating student. We leave it to the Institute to decide on the automatic collection procedure, whether it is at the start of new students' programs (beginning with the new student intake of the August 2024 semester) or as part of the clearance process for graduating students (starting with the 142nd class of December 2024). The Institute can then transfer the collected amount to the AITAA Operating account with Siam Commercial Bank A/C 4060005183 at the end of each term, semester, or inter-semester, based on the number of graduates during that period.

The AITAA lifetime membership fee fosters a sense of ownership and belongingness as the new graduates are systematically integrated into the AITAA network. This integration opens pathways for professional connections with fellow alumni and encourages active participation in AITAA programs and initiatives, supporting a sustainable AIT.


AITAA HONORS 2024 DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARDEES AT 53RD GOVERNING BOARD MEETING IN LAOS




AITAA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETINGS ON 17 AUG AND 14 SEP

We are working diligently to finalize these plans and will share updates with you as soon as everything is confirmed. Stay tuned for more news!









CHAPTER PRESIDENTS AND EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETINGS ON JULY 6

AITAA warmly welcomes all graduates to become part of our vibrant and supportive alumni community. Together, we look forward to building lasting connections and celebrating future successes!






AITAA LOYALTY PROGRAM: STRENGTHENING TIES THROUGH COLLABORATION WITH SIAM UNIVERSITY

It is with profound sadness that we share the news of the passing of Dr. Tongchat Hongladaromp, who served as the Chairman of the AIT Board of Trustees from 2020 to 2023 and as the 3rd President of AIT Alumni Association (AITAA) from 1978 to 1981. His leadership extended to academia, served as a Professor at AIT immediately after his Doctoral Study from USA, has reflected his enduring commitment to Asian Institute of Technology (AIT). He was a beloved member of the AIT community and an extraordinary leader whose contributions have left an indelible mark on all who knew him.

Dr. Tongchat was not only an esteemed alumnus, professor, and a member of the AIT Hall of Fame, but also a distinguished figure in the corporate world, particularly with his impactful leadership at PTT (Petroleum Authority of Thailand), Expressway and Rapid Transit Authority of Thailand, and NPC (National Petrochemical Corporation) in Thailand. Throughout his illustrious career, he held senior leadership roles in numerous organizations and served as an advisor to many public and private institutions. His unwavering dedication to excellence and his passion for advancing education (e.g., AIT, KMUTT) and industry alike were an inspiration to us all.

Dr. Tongchat was the recipient of numerous prestigious Royal Thai Orders and Decorations, reflecting his outstanding contributions to the nation. Throughout his remarkable career, Dr. Tongchat exemplified the values of integrity, humility, and service. His legacy is reflected in the countless lives he touched - students, colleagues, and peers alike - and in the institutions and communities that continue to thrive because of his vision and leadership.

To his fellow alumni and colleagues, we extend our deepest condolences during this time of loss. Dr. Tongchat's memory will remain a guiding light, reminding us to strive for the ideals he so deeply cherished. As we mourn his passing, let us also celebrate his life and honor his enduring legacy by carrying forward the principles he stood for.
